JOINT MEMBERSHIP DUES DECLARATION FORM

The annual dues amount is for joint membership in both the NJPMA and the National Pest Management Association, which is based on the annual sales dollar volume for the preceding 12-month period ending May 31st, or the fiscal year during this period.

Annual dollar sales volume shall be for services rendered including, but not limited to, applications or release of pesticides or fumigant gases, distribution of baits, inspection, lawn ornamental and tree pest control or weed control. It does not include over-the-counter sale of products. All other categories subject to the N.J Department of Environmental Protection pesticide regulations are included.

In computation of the annual gross dollar sales volume, a member shall include its service in all locations, including offices located within the state of New Jersey, or any pest control firm affiliated with a company.
